

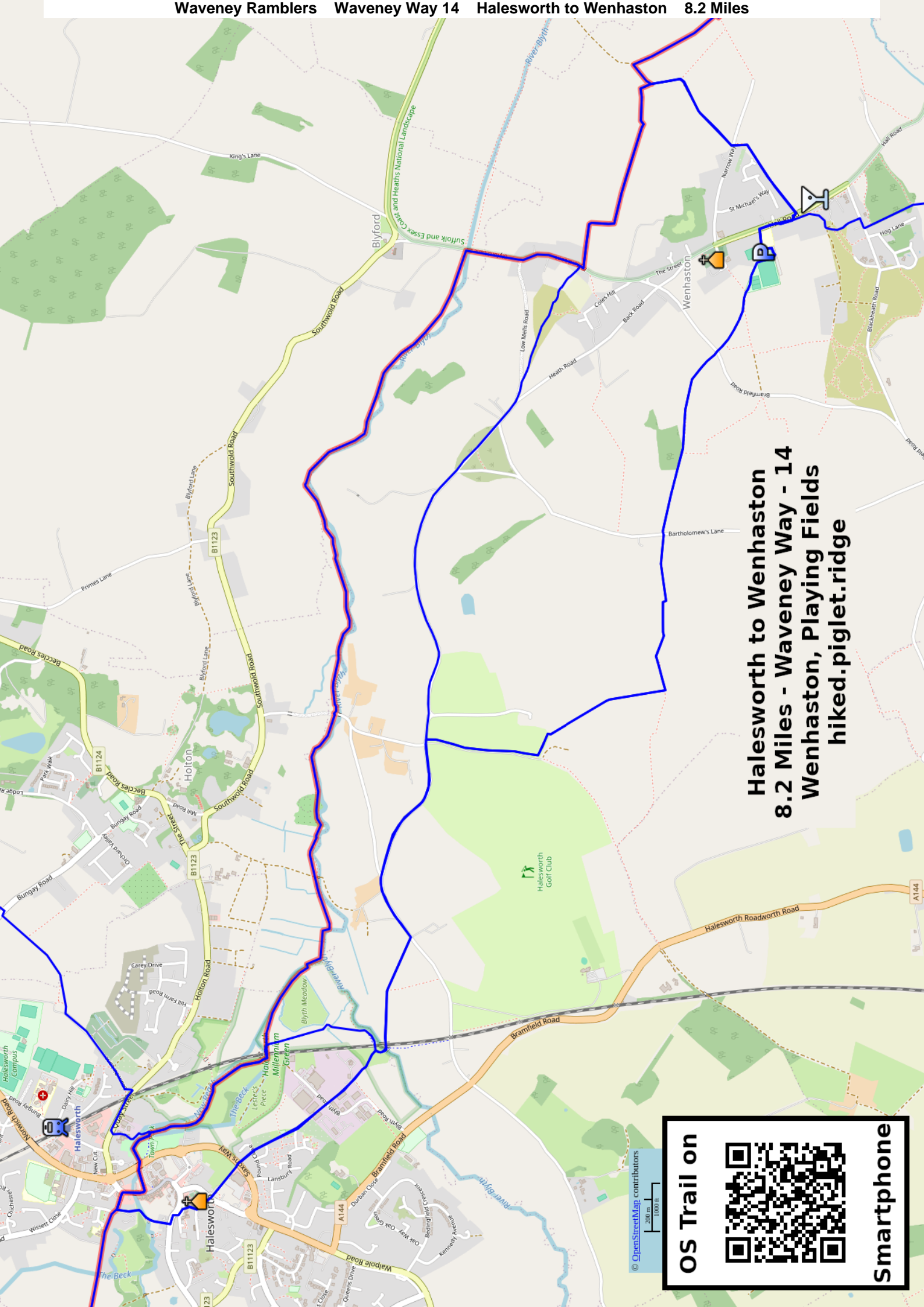
Waveney Ramblers Waveney Way 14 Halesworth to Wenhaston

Park at the Wenhaston Playing Fields. Head down the narrow lane beside the primary school. There is a lot more parking in the field left of and behind the pavillion.

Head NW across the playing fields keeping to the right hand perimeter.
Head to the NW corner. Head NW between two fields then bear right, NW, paddock left.
At Bramfield Road, cross and head NW, hedge right. Cross Bartholomew's Lane, west, hedge right.
Kink right and left, west, trees left. Cross a stile.
Cross a field diagonally (west). Aim for the NW corner and head through the gap.
Head west through the gate, hedge right then right through the hedge gap, north, hedge left.
Go through the gap, over the sleeper bridge and cross the open field, NW.
Aim to the right of the brick farm buildings opposite.
Cross the footbridge and bear left, NW, along the golf course perimeter.
Keep left heading NW, soon north. At the tarmac road, turn left, west.
Merge with another road and continue west towards Halesworth.
After Red House Farm, opposite a wide farm track, turn right, up the bank.
Go through the kissing gate, NW, diagonally across the field. Aim for the railway bridge.
Cross the footbridge, through the hedge gap and head west across the open field.
Cross under the railway. Cross the river and join a tarmac footpath, north.
Before the path crosses under the railway, turn left, NW, towards warehouses, Swan Lane.
Continue on this path, NW, across multiple roads including Saxons Way.
Head NW, along Steeple End, church right. Bear right, north, to the Market Place.
Head NW, then north, along the Market Place. Turn left, west, along Cheddiston Street.
Turn right, north, along Rectory Lane. Cross the river. Turn right, east, along Rectory Street.
Turn right, south, along the pedestrianised Bridge Street.
Turn left, east, under a brick arch. Cross the car park, keeping left.
Cross under the A144, river left, toilets right. Follow the river.
Turn left over the footbridge, then right, south, skatepark left.
Continue south along the N1 cycle route, water both sides.
Ignore the turning to Folly and Holton Road. Head SE, river left, still on tarmac.
Continue south, railway left. Turn left, east, under the railway.
In the meadow, turn off the tarmac cycle path and head east, water left.
Kink left and right, through a kissing gate and across a bridge.
Head SE, water right. Continue mostly east for a mile via several fields, bridges and gates, always with the river right.
At tarmac, cross over and continue east past the wier, river right for another mile.
Cross multiple fields via gates, stiles and hedge gaps, river right.
At Blyford Lane, tarmac, turn right, south and cross the river.
Head past houses, then left up steps.
Head east, along a raised path with a vertical drop down to a driveway.
The path bends right, south, then left, east. Head right, SE, and pass Low Farm.
Turn right, SW. At the crossroads, go ahead, south. The path bends right, SW.
Drop down to Hall Road and turn right, NW.
After the school, turn left along the narrow lane to return to the car park.

For refreshments, the Wenhaston Star is 300 metres south of the Primary School.
